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CATEGORY QUALIFICATIONS & INFORMATION

Appropriate affiliation fees are to be applied to all subscriptions as follows. All members over the age of 18 pay £14.50 for the Scottish Golf Union levy. Gentlemen pay an additional £3 levy to Clackmannan County Golf Union, CCGU

Senior Members, Aged over 60 with 10 years continuous "Full" membership are eligible for discounted fees as set at AGMs

Country Members, Must reside a minimum of 30 Miles from the clubhouse. Eligible Country Members can obtain a managed handicap and play in Braehead G.C competitions.

5 - Day Members, Are permitted to play anytime Monday to Friday, they can obtain a managed handicap and play in Braehead G.C midweek competitions.

Joint membership, Is available to any cohabiting couples residing at the same address, as per Scottish Law.

Junior Under 16s Membership, Fee includes a minimum of 5 group lessons with our PGA Professional and free access to a range of golf clubs and accessories suitable for all ages and abilities.
