

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR YOUNG PEOPLE

As a junior or juvenile member of Braehead Golf Club you are expected to abide by the following code of conduct.

You should:

- Help create and maintain an environment free of fear and harassment.
- Demonstrate fair play and apply golf's rules and standards both on and off the course.
- Treat others as you would wish to be treated yourself.
- Respect physical, cultural and racial difference.
- Tell someone in authority if you are leaving a venue or competition.
- Treat organisers, coaches and golf club members and staff with respect.

* You should not:

- * Take part in any irresponsible, abusive, inappropriate or illegal behaviour.
- * Smoke tobacco products or consume alcohol.
- Use illegal or performance-enhancing drugs or stimulants.
- Play the gaming machines or gamble in any way.
- Use foul or abusive language on the golf course or clubhouse.
- Put critical or disrespectful descriptions of others on social media forums.

Violations of this Code of Conduct will be dealt with by the committee.
